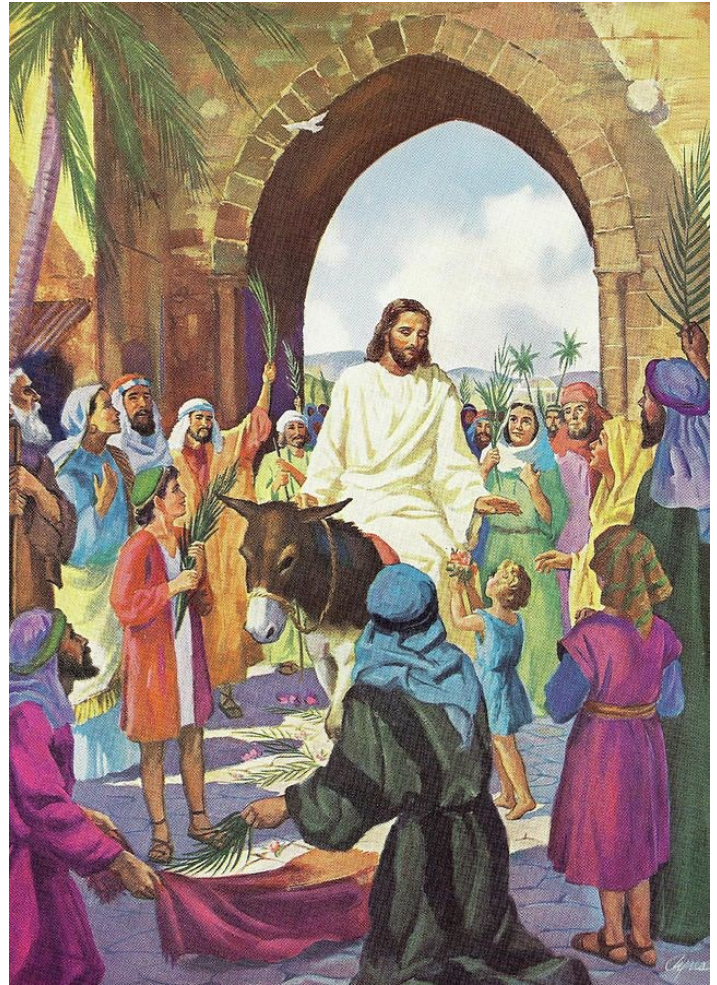

Offering of the Mass



By virtue of the “communion of saints,” the Church commends the dead to God’s mercy and offers her prayers especially the holy sacrifice of the Eucharist, on their behalf. (Catechism of the Catholic Church). This practice dates as far back as Judas collecting a sin-offering for the dead, making atonement so they might be delivered from their sin. (2 Maccabees 12:39-45). Masses may also be offered for the intentions of the living or in thanksgiving. Masses are requested through the parish office.

Palm Sunday



As we celebrate Palm Sunday, we enter into the solemn beginning of Holy Week, recalling both Christ’s triumphant entry into Jerusalem and the Passion that follows. The liturgy invites us to walk closely with Jesus, embracing both the joy of His kingship and the sacrifice of His love.

With palms in our hands, we proclaim Him as our King, yet we are also called to reflect on the ways we remain faithful to Him in our daily lives. This is a moment to renew our commitment to follow Christ with sincerity, humility, and trust, even when the path leads us to the Cross.

May this sacred day deepen our faith and prepare our hearts to journey through Holy Week with reverence, gratitude, and hope, as we look forward to the promise of the Resurrection.
