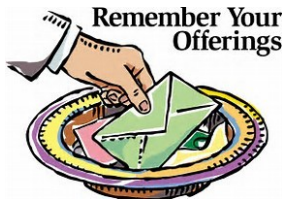
Also, please let your parish know if you are entering the hospital.

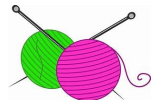
## TF140: Relics Of Padre Pio In Regina
